

Military Family Support Mission

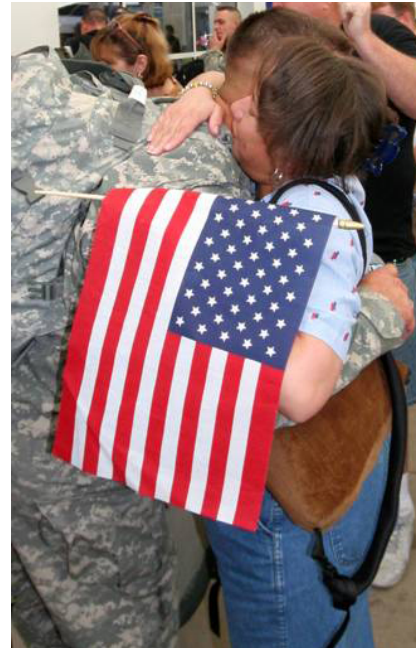


Purpose: To bring together family members of military personnel to share information, experiences, and offer emotional support and prayers for each other.
